- Print off your image

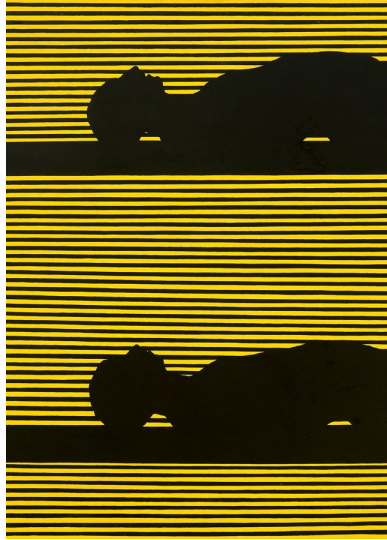

## ROBERT RAUSCHENBERG

American painter and graphic artist whose early works anticipated the pop art movement

## IDELLE WEBER

Idelle Weber (born 1932) is an American artist most closely aligned with the pop art and photorealist movements

## ROY LICHTENSTEIN

During the 1960s, along with Andy Warhol, Jasper Johns, and James Rosenquist among others, he became a leading figure in the new art movement



## POP ART

Based on popular culture;, emphasizing the banal or kitschy elements often through the use of irony

## KITSCH

Art or other objects that, generally speaking, appeal to popular rather than "high art" tastes
