STENCILS - BANKSY





Banksy is an anonymous street artist, vandal, political activist, and film director, active since the 1990s. His subversive work combines dark humour with graffiti executed in a distinctive stencilling technique. His works have been featured on streets, walls, and bridges of cities throughout the world.

HOW TO DO IT

- Sketch out your design or use a photograph as a starting point
- Shade the areas of the design that you want to cut out
- Make 'bridges' as necessary in your design - think of the letter 'O' if you wanted to stencil it you couldn't cut all the way round the centre as it would just fall out
- Simplify your design where necessary
- Copy your design onto thick card or acetate
- Use a craft knife to cut out your design - remember to use a cutting board
- Use masking tape to stick your stencil down before painting it

American contemporary artist born in 1971 and graduated from the Maryland Institute College of Art. He lives and works in Brooklyn, New York
